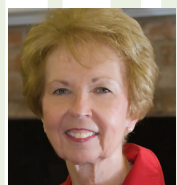

CARLA AND COLE DAWSON



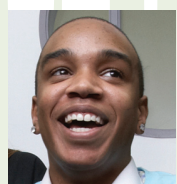
